

Student Data Wall Design Example

This is one possible example of how to set up your student data wall (SDW). Ultimately, your SDW should reflect your students and classroom community.

Strength/Interest/Experience Charts: You may choose to hang up each student's personalized SIL chart so that they can be easily seen and referenced by all students throughout the unit.

Multiple Intelligences Charting: Once students have identified their multiple intelligences, create eight columns—one for each intelligence—with that intelligence and a short definition or examples of what each intelligence means. Then let the students write their names in the column(s) that represent them.

Additional Data: You may choose to disaggregate some of the data from your students' SIL charts and plot them here. For example, you may want to break down favorite subject, learning preferences, etc. into their own data block. It is important that students' names be attached to their data for the purposes of this unit.
